
SUBJECT: Advisory Board on Veterans Dose Reconstruction Charter

This memorandum provides the Charter for the establishment of an Advisory Board on Veterans Dose Reconstruction.

Congress directed the Secretaries of Department of Defense and Veterans Affairs (VA) under Section 601 of Public Law (PL) 108-183 to appoint an advisory board to provide on-going independent review and oversight of the Veterans Dose Reconstruction Program.

The establishment of the Advisory Board on Veterans Dose Reconstruction is essential for maintaining independent oversight of the improvement and quality management of the procedures used by Defense Threat Reduction Agency (DTRA) and VA in responding to claims filed by atomic veterans. The advisory board will also provide an avenue for improving communication with veterans and for resolving complex issues related to dose reconstruction and claims adjudication.

Both DTRA and VA have reviewed and endorse the Advisory Board on Veterans Dose Reconstruction Charter.
